



Subcommittee Descriptions

Marketing Committee: will assume the responsibility of executing a calendar-based marketing strategy clearly communicating and promoting Marcus Garvey mission in the community.

Special Events Committee will provide leadership for the entire event planning process. Committee Members will orchestrate the overall production, provide suggestions and advice as needed, and be prepared to make final decisions. (Mardi Gras, Prom, Graduation, Black History Program- Feb 26th)

Fathers of Garvey Committee: will play a major role and assume full responsibility with the beautification of the physical grounds of the school. Mentoring young brothers (brother-to-brother program), recycling, life skills, training and career development.

Fundraiser Committee: Will assume the responsibility for entire fundraising planning process and execution of each event. Fundraising committee will report directly to the Special Events committee before and after each fundraising event.
